A **SPONSOR** can be an individual or company who donates either cash, goods or services which will be utilised over a full season (18 weeks) or longer eg. major equipment purchases or uniform sponsorship.

United Starz Netball offers 2 levels of sponsorship.

Club Sponsorship benefits all players (226 in 2014), Coaches (26 in 2014) and Team Managers (30 in 2014) and enables the club to make substantial equipment purchases that would, if feasible, display the sponsor's logo for the life of the item.

Team Sponsorship benefits an individual team/s as specified by the sponsor. Items purchased would if feasible, display the sponsor's logo for the life of the item. Our teams comprise a minimum of 7 players up to a maximum of 10, a Coach, possibly an assistant Coach and a Team Manager.

A **SUPPORTER** can be an individual or company who donates either cash, goods or services for an individual event eg. sausages for a sausage sizzle or raffle prizes etc. Although not acknowledged on our website, Supporters are thanked through 'Shooting Starz' and 'United Chatters' and if possible 'liked' on our facebook page.



RULE OF THE WEEK - OFFSIDE AND OUT OF COURT

A player called for an Offside or Out of Court penalty is not out of play and is able to defend immediately.

One Player Offside – **Penalty:** [A Free Pass to the opposing team where the infringement occurred.](#)

- A player with or without the ball shall be offside if the player enters any area other than the playing area for the designated position
- A player may reach over and take the ball from an offside area or may lean on the ball in an offside area provided no physical contact is made with the ground in the offside area

The ball is out of Court when:- **Penalty –** [A Throw In to the team opposing the one who has had contact with the ball, to be taken where the ball crossed the line.](#)

- It touches the ground outside the Court
- It touches an object of person in contact with the ground outside the Court
- It is held by a player in contact with the ground, an object or a person outside the Court

Penalty – A Throw In to the opposing team, at the point where the player was out of Court.

- A ball which hits any part of the Goalpost and rebounds into play, is not out of Court
- A player is out of Court, if at the time of touching or receiving the ball any part of that player is touching the ground, an object or person outside the Court
- A player having no contact with the ball may stand or move out of Court but, before playing the ball, the player must re-enter the Court and no longer have contact with the ground out of Court

Penalty – Penalty Pass/Shot to the opposing team where the infringer was standing.

- If the ball is caught simultaneously by two opposing players, one of whom lands out of Court, a Toss Up is taken on Court between the two players concerned where the incident occurred
- A player who has left the Court to retrieve the ball or to take a Throw In must be permitted direct re-entry to the Court

Penalty – Free Pass to the opposing team where the ball was when play was stopped. The player concerned shall leave the Court until the next goal is scored or until the next interval.

- A player who goes out of Court for **no valid reason** (ie. Not to take a Throw In or collect a ball or secure a better playing position) **may not** enter the game while play is in progress but, after notifying the Umpire, may take the Court:
- Immediately after a goal has been scored
- At a stoppage for injury or illness
- Immediately following an interval.
